

# CITY PROFILE

## VAUGHAN

Regional Municipality of York

- Vaughan is one of Canada's fastest growing communities with a population of over 250,000 people.
- Easy access to Highways 400, 427, 27 and 407.
- Canadian National (CN) and Canadian Pacific (CP), Canada's two principal railways, have their largest classification yard and intermodal freight terminal in Vaughan.
- Vaughan is served by 2 airports, Lester B. Pearson International Airport and Buttonville Airport.
- York Region Transit/VIVA is integrated along many routes with the TTC and Brampton Transit. New subway connections are being planned to integrate seamlessly with TTC.
- Vaughan is a net importer of jobs, with an employment labour force of 150,000 compared to a resident labour force of over 101,000.
- In 2006, Vaughan ranked fourth in Canada's Top 10 Cities for Families (Canadian Family Magazine) with high scores for education, ethnic diversity, family health care, childcare, low crime rate and economic well-being.

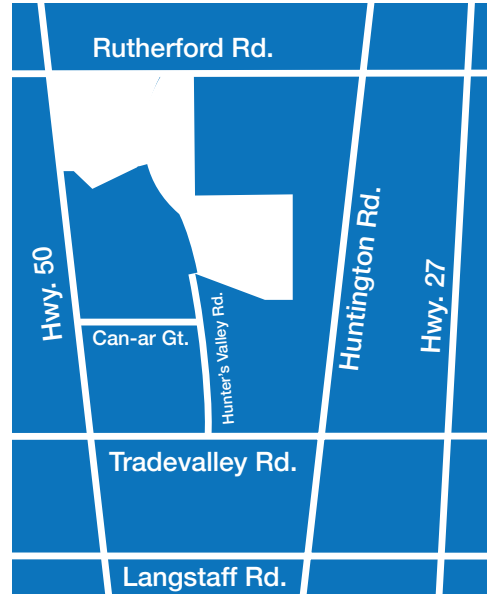
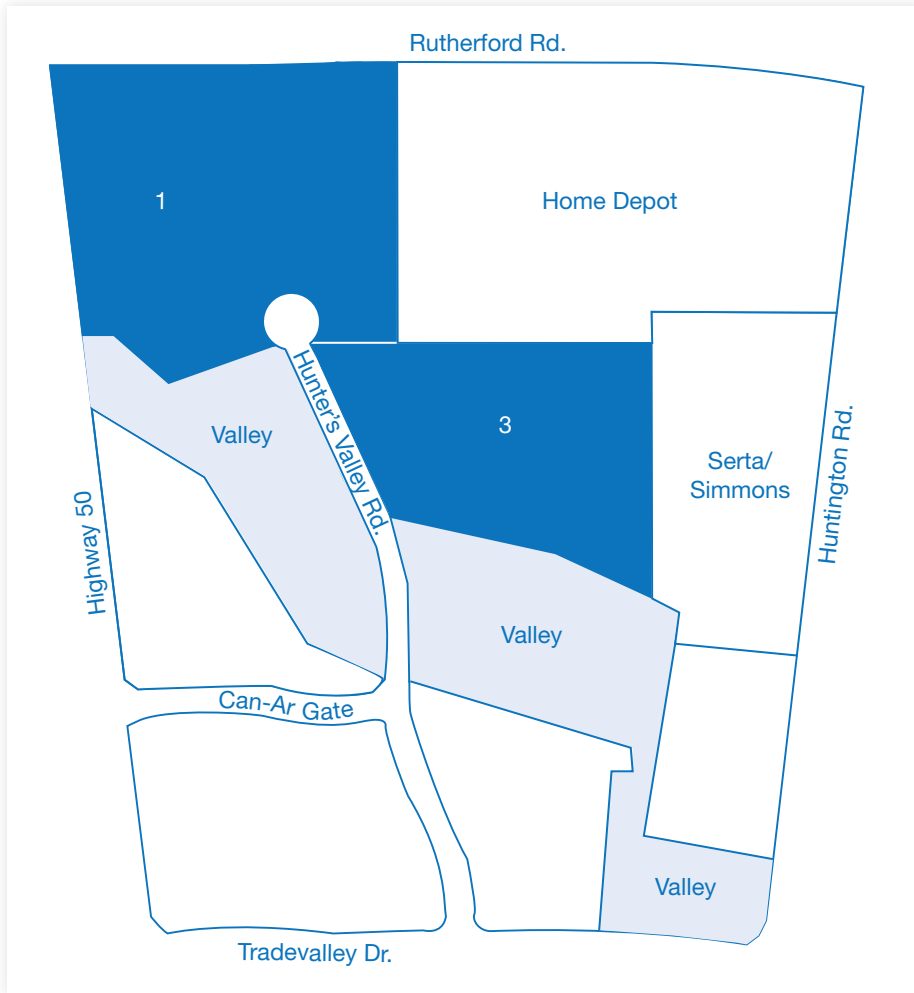
